### INTENDED USE

For marking out lines on football pitches, lawn Tennis courts and other turf surfaces.

Application by pressurised line marking machine when diluted with water.

Suitability for other uses acetate/co-polymer emulsion using organic and inorganic pigments and extenders.

### COMPOSITION

A water based Poly vinly acetate/co-polymer emulsion using organic and inorganic pigments and extenders.

### HEALTH HAZARDS

An occupational exposure limit (OEL) has been established by the Health & Safety Commission for the following materials, and should always be observed.

### PRECAUTIONS IN HANDLING AND USE

Avoid the inhalation of vapours and spray mist by the provision of good natural ventilation, sufficient to keep airborne concentrations below the OEL during the application and drying of liquid films.

Avoid contact with eyes and wash off skin with water and mild detergent. Keep containers closed except when in use.

### **FIRST AID PROCEDURE**

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air, keep patient warm and at rest  
Eye Contact: Irrigate copiously with clean, fresh water, for at least 10 minutes, holding the eyelids apart.  
Skin Contact: Remove contaminated clothing, wash skin thoroughly with soap and water, or use a proprietary skin cleanser.

Do not use solvents or thinners.

Ingestion: There is no hazard by this route in normal industrial activities. If accidentally swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Keep at rest and obtain medical advice.

### **STORAGE**

Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place.  
Protect from frost.  
Keep out of reach of children.

### **FIRE PREVENTION**

The liquid paint is neither flammable, nor will it support combustion.
